Dear Christine,

I am just following up on the telephone conversation we had on Friday last, 2nd August. Well you were right, the wording of the proposal for no. 71 is as you thought, what is on the application form on line.

Why did we think anything with this would be straight forward! I would like to refer you to a letter we received on 31/05/13, from Gordon Atkinson/ Lynne Brennan, in response to our objection to the increase height of the wall above the two storey extension, considered to be providing a roof terrace. The letter advises us that a planning application is required for this addition. So when we got the letter from Planning on Friday we assumed it was regarding the 'roof terrace' as I guess did you, having previously communicated with you on this matter.

After speaking to you, you agreed that a second letter would be forwarded to us and relevant neighbours. We now understand that the letter we received is about the building of a patio wall rather than a fence (condition of their planning approval) and not the roof extension. Should we go ahead and respond to the planning notification now? And await a second application for the roof detail? Or will your department go back to Mr Haig to request he submit an application including all the unapproved works.
